

Regulation of the trail at Gropada

The project's partner, the Municipality of Triest, has in this year (2012) successfully completed the first of the two planned infrastructure initiatives, namely the regulation of forest roads and the trail at Gropada and Trebče. The construction work, the implementation of which had envisaged the consumption of resources in the amount of more than € 100,000, included the leveling of floors, the removal of undergrowth, other shrubs and the trees on the edges of the trails. In addition, the work included the removal of the accumulated material (soil and stones) in the width of three metres, the demolition and the disposal of nibs of hard rock, the crushing of the present material, the construction and connection of transverse and longitudinal ditches into the network and the construction of freeing ports of collected rainwater. At the same time some of the dry walls and roadside rest areas have been restored, and in addition, also 8 wooden information boards were erected with the content and pictures on the peculiarities of Karst: one board is intended for the orientation activities. Such roads and paths connect villages in the area of Gropada and Trebče in the total length of 11 km.
